my son Joshua Pritchett one Gun and fifteen pounds cash to him his
heirs and assigns forever. Item I give and bequeath to my son John
Pritchett fifteen pounds cash to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item
I give and bequeath to my son James Pritchett fifteen pounds in lieu of
a feather Bed and thirty pounds cash towards raising and schooling to
him his heirs and assigns forever also my will and desire is that my
Tract of Land lying in Brunswick County containing two Hundred
and fifty five Acres, ^{the same} more or less may be sold and all the rest of my Estate

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also one blue Chest and all my wearing apparel and twenty two dollars
