

In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Wager,
do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say. First
I give and bequeath to Rebecca Clark five Negroes to wit, Robt, Violet, Madlow
Hansen and Billy provided she pays to Mary Mossering eldest Daughter
of Henry Smith and Elizabeth Tuckins Daughter of George Bryer each
fifteen hundred pounds of Petersburg Inspected Crop Tobacco and shall
either pay up the said Tobacco before the Negroes are delivered or give Bond
and such Security as my Executors hereafter mentioned shall think
sufficient. Item I give and bequeath to Mary Smith Daughter of
Samuel Magot One Negroe Girl named Sally to her and her heirs for ever.
Item I give and bequeath to Nicholas Bryer two Negroes, to wit, Mary and
her Male Child to him and his for ever. Item I give and bequeath to
William Tomlinson One hundred pounds Lawful Money of Virginia
to him and heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to Rebecca Waller
Daughter of William Waller Twenty pounds Lawful Money of Virginia
to her and heirs for ever. Item I desire that my Executors may pay four
pounds towards the Schooling of Sally Barnes Daughter of John Barnes
and for no other purpose whatsoever. Item I lend to Ann Robt fifty
pounds during her natural life and at her Death I give the said

ounds during her natural life and at her Death I give the said
Money to her Daughter, Elizabeth Robt. to her and her heirs for ever.
Item I give Benjamin Chapman Twelve pounds ten Shillings to
be paid by my Executors or some other person appointed by them in order
to get him Clothes &c. Item I give to Samuel Byer, Twenty five
Pounds Virginia Money to him and his heirs for ever. Item My Will
and desire is that all the residue of my Estate of what kind soever be sold
in Order to discharge my just Debts and Legacies as above and further
it is my desire that my Negroes be sold in families and choose their own
Masters provided they sell for near their Value or my Executors may sell
them at private sale or in any other manner they think best and if there
should not be Estate sufficient to discharge all the Debts and Legacies
in full In that case my desire is that the Legacies receive in due
proportion. I do constitute my friends Walter Peter and John Rogers
Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Revoking all others
heretofore made by me. My Will and desire is that my Executor John
Rogers receive twenty Pounds for his Services therein or the Balance
if any optionally in him of my Estate after my Debts are paid

in the Penalty of two thousand pounds conditioned as the Law
directs Certificate was granted them for obtaining a Probate thereof
