and bequeath to my Nephew James Spann Son of Willis Spann fifteen Dollars to him &
his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Balfield Warren the sum of fifteen
Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Robert B
Mary the sum of fifteen Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my
Nephew Henry Spann, Son of Richard Spann, the sum of fifteen Dollars to him and his
heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to Jones Warren all the rest and residue of my Estate
not herein disposed of; of what nature or kind soever and wheresoever found to him and his
heirs and assigns forever. Lastly I do hereby appoint my friend Jones Warren Executor of,
this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made

this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made.

by the oaths of Edmund H Tellar and Edmunds Mason the Witnesses thereto and

acknowledged their bond in the Penalty of One thousand Dollars Conditioned as
