and bequeath to my Nephew James Sparr Son of Wells Sparr fifteen Dollars to him &
his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Belfield Warren the sum of fifteen
Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Robert B
Mary the sum of fifteen Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my
Nephew Henry Sparr, Son of Richard Sparr, the sum of fifteen Dollars to him and his
heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to Jones Warren all the rest and residue of my Estate
not herein disposed of, of what nature or kind soever and wheresoever found to him and his
heirs and assigns forever. Lastly I do hereby appoint my friend Jones Warren Executor of,
this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made

Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Robert B

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Maby the sum of fifteen Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my

Nephew Henry Sparr, son of Richard Sparr, the sum of fifteen Dollars to him and his

heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to Jones Mann all the rest and residue of my estate

not herein disposed of, of what nature or kind soever and wheresoever found to him and his

heirs and assigns forever. Lastly I do hereby appoint my friend Jones Mann Executor of,

this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made.

acknowledged their bond in the Penalty of One thousand Dollars conditioned as
