age of eighteen years of age or marries one Negro Girl by name of F. L. P. K.
if obtained as I have a suit depending for the said Girl with George Thawell
also one feather Bed and furniture and one Seal. Then I give and bequeath
to her and her heirs forever. Then I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Ann Allen the following Property to wit one Negro Girl named Annan one
feather Bed and furniture and one large blue Chest when she arrives
to the age of eighteen years or marries to her her heirs and assigns forever
in Case one of my before named Children should die without an heir it
is my Will the other should have that's property. Then I give and bequeath
unto my beloved Wife Lucy Allen all the residue of my household and
kitchen Furniture also one Black or White Girl.
