Daughter Dorcas Dufree one Cow and Calf to her and her heir and

the sum of Twenty five pounds Virginia Money to be raised out of my

The sum of Twenty five pounds Virginia money to be paid out of my Estate to her and her heirs and assigns forever, I also give to my grand Daughter Brambley Duface the sum of Twenty five pounds to be given as above mentioned to her and her heirs and assigns forever. Item I give to my Grand Daughter Longland Duface the sum of thirty pounds to be paid out of my Estate to her and her heirs and assigns forever. Item my will and desire is that all the remainder, including my Estate not heretofore given away be sold by my Executors at their discretion hereafter to be accounted by me, and the monies from such sales to be equally divided between my Sons Jacob Harley William and Thomas Duface to them their heirs and assigns forever, I do hereby appoint Lewis Duface Jacob Duface and William Duface my whole and sole Executors to this my last Will and Testament. furniture & writing almanac etc to her to have & to hold
