Greenville and Parish of Saint Andrews do make this my last Will &
Testament in manner and form following to wit, I praym, my desire
is that all my just debts be paid. Item, I bequeath unto my loving wife
Wilmette Bailey during her natural life the Land and plantation
whereon I now live with all my negroes now on the plantation,
with all my stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep, and Hogs, Household &
Kitchen furniture and plantation utensils. Item, After the death of
my said wife I give and bequeath to my son Brittain Bailey
the Land and plantation that my wife during her natural life to
him his heirs and assigns forever. Item, I give and bequeath to my
said sons namely Hadrach Bailey, Henry Bailey, Philip Bailey, Wyatt
Bailey, and Bolton Bailey my five following negroes with their future
increase to wit, Blot, Jeff, Hinga, Leroy, and Lewis, to them their heirs
and assigns forever (and if either or my said sons die before they are
possessed of their share then to go into their estate, the said negroes with
their future increase to be equally divided as above mentioned),
Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Wilmette Bailey one feather
bed and furniture called and valued by the family as hers, also fifty
Dollars cash, to her and her heirs and assigns forever I also direct and

and assigns forever (and if either of my said sons die before they are
possessed of their share then to go into their estate, the said Negroes with
their future increase to be equally divided as above mentioned),
Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Wilmoth Bailey one feather
bed and furniture called and known by the family as hers, also fifty
Dollars Cash, to her and her heirs and assigns forever I also direct and
enjoin it on all my then living children that they each of them jointly
shall maintain her my said daughter as to house and home and
provision during the time she shall live single. Item, I give and
bequeath to my two daughters Rebecca Underwood and Elizabeth
Byell all my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep, and Hogs also my House
hold and Kitchen furniture and plantation utensils aforesaid unto
my wife, at her death, to be equally divided provided they join
with my sons equally in supporting my daughter Wilmoth as aforesaid
directed to them and their heirs and assigns forever. Item, my will and
desire is that whatever I may have given to either of my children
during my lifetime be confirmed to them. And lastly I do hereby
nominate and appoint my son Shadrach Bailey, and my son
Philip Bailey Executors of this my last will and testament hereby
