114) will and desire is that after my just debts and funeral Expenses are paid, five hundred Dollars be raised out of any part of my Estate, but my personal Estate to be first sold for that purpose and when raised, to be paid to Polly M. Hobbs, daughter of Howell Hobbs, which I give to her, her heirs & assigns forever. My will and desire is that my Mother Susanna Mabry shall have the use and enjoyment of all the remaining part of my Estate of every kind during her life, and after her death, my will and desire is that my Estate be sold, and equally divided amongst all my Brothers and Sisters then alive, which I give to them and their heirs & assigns forever. My will and desire is that my Executor hereafter named shall give no security for the execution of this my last Will and Testament, and that no Inventory to be returned and recorded, nor appraisement be taken and made of my Estate. I constitute nominate and appoint my worthy friend Ingrain Blanks my sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament. In Testimony of all herein
