Will and Testament as follows to wit, First my will and desire is that all my

of my Land the part that she may choose two Negroes namely Peter and

 Plantation Utensils and all my House hold and Kitchen Furniture
 to raise maintain and School my Children upon for or during her life
 or widow hood. Then I give and bequeath to my said wife two Negroes
 namely Poll and Clary one feather Bed and furniture one Horse and
 Saddle to her and her heirs and assigns forever, and thirty Bunches of corn
 and four hundred pounds of Cotton to her and her heirs forever. Then I
 give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy Fox four Negroes namely
 Rezek, Nathan, Isham, Harriett and their increase to her then her
 and assigns forever. Then I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally
 Fox three Negroes namely James, Tom, and Kate to her and her
 heirs and assigns forever. Then I will that my Negro Girl Agg and
 the balance of my Negroes not before disposed of to be sold to pay my
 debts and should there be any money left after my just debts were
 paid from the Sale of the said Negro and Crop the balance if any
 I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Fox to her and her heirs
 and assigns forever. Then I give and bequeath all my Land to
 my two Daughters Lucy and Sally Fox to them and their heirs
 and assigns forever. Then I do hereby nominate and appoint
 my said Son Wm. M. Fox Executor of my said Will.
