last Will and Testament in manner and form following
I ~~imprisoned~~ give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Ann
Allen one feather Bed and furniture and fifty pounds cash to be
raised out of my Estate when she arrives to the age of twenty one
Years or has an heir of her Body lawfully begotten but if she
should die before she arrives to that age or has such heir the
legacy left her is still to remain as my Estate. Item I give and
bequeath to my Son Timothy Allen one feather Bed & furniture
also one corral lot that is now call'd his to him and his heirs
forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Son Benjamin Allen
one feather Bed and furniture and five pounds cash to be raised
out of my Estate to him and his heirs forever. Item I leave to
my loving Wife Martha Allen all the rest of my Estate both real &
personal not already disposed of during her natural life to raise and
school my children on, and after her death with my will and desire is
that all my Estate that I have lost my wife may be equally divided

between my four Children vizt Aaron Allen, Timothy Allen, Benja-
min Allen, and Holton Lacey to them and their heirs forever my will

stitute and appoint my ~~heirs~~ Aaron Allen, and Timothy Allen
Executors of this my last Will and Testament revoking all other wills
by me heretofore made in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 26th Day of November 1795.
