Greensville County, Virginia Wills, Book 2, 1806 to 1816
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I James Powell of the County of Greensville and State of Virginia do hereby make
my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following that is to say First I give
my last debts and funeral expenses be paid. Secondly after the payment of my debts and
funeral expenses I give to my Mother Sarah Powell all my Estate both real and personal
of what nature or kind soever it may be to her and her heirs and assigns forever. And last
I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved mother Sarah Powell executrix of the
last will and Testament, hereby revoking all other or former wills or Testaments by me heretofore
made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
26th day of November 1813.

Recorded. And on the motion of Sarah Powell the executrix therein named who made oath
thereof and together with James C. Fennell her Surety entered into and acknowledged
their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs last made
was granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form.

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
