In the name of God, Amen, I James Robinson of Greensville County
and State of Virginia, being weak and low in health but in sound and disposing
memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner &
form as follows (Viz.) First and principally I recommend my Soul to the
mercy of Almighty God that gave it, hoping a gracious acceptance of the
same and also what worldly Goods as it hath pleased God to endow me
with I dispose of in the following manner (Viz.) First I promise and
bequeath unto my beloved Wife Winnifred Robinson the whole of my Lands—
until my son Darius Robinson arrives to the Age of eighteen Years at
which time my Will and desire is that there should be a division in
my said Lands in manner and form as follows (to wit.) To my Wife
Winnifred Robinson I lend four hundred Acres of Land for and during
her natural life or Widowhood known by the name of Butler's, Sanier's,
and Collier's and from and immediately thereafter I give the said Four
Hundred Acres of Land to my Son, Robert River Robinson to him
and

435) and his heirs and assigns forever. — Also at the above mentioned time of my son
Darius Robinson's arriving to the age of Eighteen Years, my will and desire is
that there should be an equal division of the balance of my Land between my
other two sons namely Darius Robinson and James Fox Robinson to them
and their heirs and assigns forever. — Item I also lend to my wife Winnifred
Robinson four Negroes namely Jim, David Jude and old Jenny also four
cows and calves one sow and pigs one feather bed and furniture one tray
more known by the name of Boll, one Saddle and also all the provision
that laid in for the support of Family or stock for the present Year —
and my will and desire is that the plantation that I have above lent to my
Wife Winnifred Robinson for and during her natural life or widowhood
should be a home for my children until they marry or become of lawful
Age and to be supported and educated out of the property before lent to my
Wife Winnifred Robinson. — Item I give unto my daughter Betsy
Robinson two Negroes namely Moses and Amy with their future increase
also one mare known by the name of the Morris filly also two cows and
calves one feather bed and furniture and one Saddle and Bridle to her

Calves one feather Bed and furniture and one Saddle and Bridle to her and her heirs and assigns forever. —

Item I give unto my daughter Susanna Robinson three Negroes namely Annice, Mourning and Sterling, with their future increase also one feather Bed and furniture two Cows and Calves and one Horse worth twenty five pounds also one Saddle and Bridle to her and her heirs and assigns forever. —

Item I give unto my daughter Rebekah Robinson two Negroes namely yellow Lucy and Burwell with their future increase also one feather Bed and furniture two Cows and Calves and one Horse worth twenty five pounds — and one Saddle and Bridle to her and her heirs and assigns forever. —

Item I give unto my Daughter Nancy Winsor Robinson one Negroe Girl known by the name of little Lucy with her future increase also one feather Bed and furniture two Cows and Calves and one Horse worth twenty five pounds & one Saddle and Bridle to her and her heirs and assigns forever. —

Item I give unto my son Darius Robinson one Negroe by the name of Sawney also one Horse worth twenty five pounds and one Saddle and Bridle to him and his heirs and assigns forever. —

Item I give unto my Son James Robinson two Negroes namely Dennis and Sam with their

Two Cows and Calves and one Horse worth twenty five pounds also one Saddle and Bridle to her and her heirs and assigns forever. — Item

I give unto my daughter Rebekah Robinson two Negroes namely yellow Lucy and Burwell with their future increase also one feather Bed and furniture two Cows and Calves and one Horse worth twenty five pounds — and one Saddle and Bridle to her and her heirs and assigns forever. —

Item I give unto my Daughter Nancy Wilson Robinson one Negroe Girl known by the name of little Lucy with her future increase also one feather Bed and furniture two Cows and Calves and one Horse worth twenty five pounds & one Saddle and Bridle to her and her heirs and assigns forever. — Item I

give unto my son Darius Robinson one Negroe by the name of Samney also one Horse worth twenty five pounds and one Saddle and Bridle to him and his heirs and assigns forever. — Item I give unto my Son

James Fox Robinson two Negroes namely Jenny and Sam with their future increase also one Horse worth twenty five pounds and one Saddle and Bridle to him and his heirs and assigns forever. — Item I give

unto

unto my son Robert Pures Robinson Two Negroes, namely Henry & Peter
also one Horse worth Twenty five pounds, also one Saddle and Bridle
to him and his heirs and assigns forever. — My will and desire is
for the property given to my Children should remain in the hands of my
Wife Winnifred until my Children marry ^{or} arrive to the Age of Eighteen
Years, and as they marry ^{or} arrive to that Age, she namely my Wife is to
pay them of their full Legacy agreeable to my will, and my will is that
if my Wife should die that it shall be in the power of my Brother
Littleberry Robinson to take my Childrens property out of the hands
of my Wife and for him to pay them off agreeable to my will. —
Then my will and desire is that the Negroes that I have lent to my wife
Winnifred Robinson after her death should be equally divided between my
son Darius Robinson and my daughter Nancy W^mson Robinson to them
and their heirs and assigns forever. — My will and desire is that
after my just debts and funeral expences are paid that the rest and
residue of my estate not before given away should be equally divided
between my son Darius Robinson, James Fox Robinson, Robert Pures

between my son Sarius Robinson, James Fox Robinson, Robert River
Robinson, Rebecca Robinson, and Nancy Wagon Robinson to them their
heirs and assigns forever. — I do appoint my Wife Winnifred Robinson
and my Brother Littleberry Robinson whole and sole Executors to this my
last Will and Testament made by me Signed Sealed and dated this
Twentieth day of February eighteen Hundred and one. —
