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In the name of God Amen. I John B. Cooksey of the County of
Greensville and Parish of Saint Andrew, being at present low in
health but in sound memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same
do appoint and ordain this my last will and testament in
manner and form following, to wit, For premises and first of
all my will and desire is that all my just debts be duly ~~paid~~
paid and discharged. Item I give and bequeath to my son
Thomas Cooksey the Land and plantation whereon I now live
containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less to him
and his heirs forever. Item I leave to my ^{loving} wife Mary Cooksey
all the remainder of my Estate real and personal during her
natural life. Item I give and bequeath to my son Charles
Cooksey, Fifteen Pounds current Money of Virginia at the
death of Mary my wife, to him and his heirs forever.
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Adams,
fifty

Fifty Pounds Current Money of Virginia, at the death of Mary
 my wife, to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath
 to my Son Hezekiah Cooksey Two Pounds Current Money of Virginia
 at the death of Mary my wife, to him and his heirs for ever.
 Item I give and bequeath to my Son Miles Cooksey Two
 Pounds Current Money of Virginia, at the death of Mary my
 wife, to him and his heirs for ever. Item I leave all the
 remainder of my Estate of what kind soever at the death
 of my wife Mary Cooksey to be equally divided between
 five of my Children, vizt, Charles Cooksey, Elizabeth
 Adams, Hezekiah Cooksey, Walter Cooksey, & Miles
 Cooksey to them and their heirs for ever. And lastly, I
 constitute and appoint my loving wife Mary Cooksey
 and M^r Edmund Heath my whole and sole Executors of this
 my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have
