men once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament, that is to say:

I recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it, for my body I commit it to the dust from whence it was taken, in sure and certain hope that I shall receive it again at the general resurrection, by the mighty hand of God, and as touching such worldly things as it hath pleased God to bestow me in this life with I give, leave and despose of the same in the manner following (To wit). Item, I will that all my just debts be paid. Item, I will that all my lands Slaves Stock to be left together till the expiration of the year one thousand eight hundred and eleven and the profits arising therefrom together with the monies due to me to be apply'd to the payment of my debts but in case the said profits and monies due me shou'd not be sufficient to discharge my debts my Executors may sell at their discretion any part of my Estate as far as to discharge all my debts.

Item, my will is that at the expiration of the year one thousand eight hundred and eleven all my lands be equally divided between my four sons namely Thomas Barnes Turner, Henry Blunt Turner, John Turner,

not be sufficient to discharge my debts my Executrix may sell at their discretion
my part of my Estate as far as to discharge all my debts.

Item. my will is that at the expiration of the year one thousand eight hundred
and eleven all my lands be equally divided between my four sons namely Howard
Barred Turner, Henry Blunt Turner, John Lugas Turner and James Turner
to them their heirs and affines forever upon the following conditions that unless
any of my sons or son above named should die before they arrive to the age of

Twenty one years & without lawful issue my lands above described to them is to be equally divided between all my surviving sons also named to them their heirs and affigies forever also that part of my lands falling by said Division to my son James Turner to be subject to the life of wife as here after named furthermore the above division of my lands is to be partitioned so as for the Lands are plantation whereon I now live to belong to my son James Turner aforesaid.

Item I send my wife Mildred Turner all that part of my lands (to be divided as above,) which shall or may be allotted to my son James Turner also as much of my other Estate Slaves Stock &c as my executors may think sufficient for the support of my said wife and the raising and educating all my children to take place at the end of the year One thousand eight hundred and eleven above named.

Item I will that the residue of my Estate of every nature at the expiration of the above term be equally divided between all my children those living to them their heirs and affigies forever.

Item my desire is that my brother Sugars Turner make a right to all the lands I have purchased of him to my son to whom the same may be allotted in the division above named also my whole Estate that is to be divided as above.

Item I will that my brother's son Sugars Turner Thomas Turner

sons aforesaid.

Peter Turner to witness to this my last will and Testament and do make and deliver
