Anne Collier one Negro Girl named Annis during her life and at her Death I
give the said Negro Girl Annis to my Grand Son Sterling Peckles Collier to have
and his heirs and assigns forever - and I give and bequeath to my said Daughter
Anne Collier Twenty five pounds, to be raised out of my Estate at the Death of my
wife to her and her heirs and assigns forever - Item I lend to my beloved wife
Mary Collier all my real Estate and the residue of my personal Estate after my
Just Debts and the legacy left Henry Collier being paid out of the negro lent
my Daughter Anne is accepted in this loan) during her natural life. Item I
give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Mose five pounds to be raised out
of my Estate at the Death of my wife to her and her heirs and assigns forever
Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Children Sons and Daughters of
William and Elizabeth Mose to wit David Judith, Richard, Nancy John
and Anne Mose five pounds each, to be raised out of my Estate at the
Death of my wife to them and their heirs and assigns forever. Item I

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gives and bequeath to my heirs, children, John and John
Collier Sons of John Collier, the sum of each to be raised out of my Estate
at the Death of my wife to them and their heirs forever. Item my wife
and I have at the Death of my wife that all the Estate left her to
be sold and after paying the charges already bequeathed the residue
be equally divided between all my Children except Elizabeth who I have
bequeathed to her, John Collier, John Collier, Mary Collier, William Collier, Stephen
Collier and Mary Collier and I hereby constitute and appoint
Pellepoor Mapes Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking
