and State of Virginia being in perfect health and Memory and calling to mind the
uncertainty of human Life do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in
in Manner and form as followeth To wit. Item. I lend to my Daughter in Law
Elizabeth Dupree the plantation whereon she now lives, containing two hun-
dred of Land more or less for and during her natural life, and from and immediately
thereafter I give and devise the said Land to my Grand Son Henry Dupree to him his
Heirs and Assigns for ever. Item. I give to my Grand Daughter Mary Justice four
Negroes, Namely Fanny, Harry, Old Dick, and Rachel to her Heirs and Assigns for
ever. Item. I give to my Grand Daughter Hannah Will Dupree two Negroes Namely
Ben and Sall, to her Heirs and Assigns for ever. Item. I give to my Grand Daughter
Faitha Dupree two Negroes (Namely) London and Cato, to her Heirs and Assigns
for ever. Item. I give to my Grand Son Henry Dupree two Negroes (Namely) Will
Young Dick, to him and his Heirs and Assigns for ever. Item. I give to Edmund
Jordan two Negroes (Namely) Charles and Thary, to him and his Heirs for ever.
Item. I give to my Son John Dupree the Plantation whereon he now lives, con-
taining One hundred and Sixty eight Acres of Land, (be the same more or less)
also eight Negroes (Namely) Israel, Anne, Luke, Patt, Arthur, Peter, Hannah,
and Grace, and their future increase to him his Heirs and Assigns for ever.
Item. I give to Merinda Foster One Negro Girl, Namely Abby, to her and her
Heirs for ever. Item. I give unto Thomas Jordan One Negro Girl (Namely) Rachel
to him and his Heirs and Assigns for ever. Item. I give unto Elizabeth
Dupree.

123] I give four Negroes Namely, Moses, Winny, Simon, and Notice to her and her
Heirs and Assigns forever also One Bed and furniture. Item I give unto
Robert Dupree three Negroes Namely, Sue, Squire, and Stephen and One
feather Bed and furniture to him and his Heirs and Assigns for ever.
Item I give unto Lewis Day Dupree, the plantation whereon I formerly lived,
also One bed and furniture to him and his Heirs and Assigns for ever.
Item I lend to my Daughter Lurania Harris four Negroes Namely, Solomon,
Moll, Austin, and Tamar for and during her natural life and from and
immediately thereafter the said Negroes to return to my Executors and equally
divided between my surviving grand children with their further increase
to them and their Heirs. Item. All the rest and residue of my Estate hereto-
fore, not given away, after my just debts and funeral expences are paid
to be divided into two equal parts, the one half to my Son John Dupree the
other half to be equally divided between the Sophams of my Son Lewis
Dupree also desire the forementioned Estate, should not be appraised. &
I do ^{heretby} appoint Isham Fearnell and John Justice Executors of this my last
Will and Testament revoking all other Wills heretofore, or at any time made
by me. In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal

At a Court held for Greenville County the 24th day of October 1788. This Will was
proved according to Law by the Oaths of Jeremiah Dupree and James Dupree
Witnesses thereto and Ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of the Executors
therein named who made Oath thereto, and together with Lewis Dupree and Jeremi
Dupree their Securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty
of two thousand pounds conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate was granted
to them for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form.
