bless me with I give and dispose in following manner:-

Impromises First of all I leave as much of my Estate to be sold as will pay all my
just debts and funeral expence:-

Item, I lend to my wife Eleanor Lightfoot all my Land one negro man name
Pegger all my stock, and Kitchen and household furniture during her widow
hood, and at the expiration of that time my will is that the Land to be equally divided
between John Batt and Thomas Lightfoots:-

Item, Give and bequeath unto my daughter Charlot and my three sons John Batt and
Thomas Lightfoot all the remainder of my Estate one negro stock of horses, cattle

rights and wish of all I recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave
it, and as for my body I recommend it to the earth to be buried in a Christian
manner and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
bless me with I give and dispose in following manner:-

Impiories First of all I leave as much of my Estate to be sold as will pay all my
just debts and funeral expence:-

Item I lend to my wife Eleanor Lightfoot all my Land one negro man name
Peggy all my stock and Kitchen and household furniture during her widow
hood, and at the expiration of that time my will is that the Land to be equally divided
between John Bath and Thomas Lightfoot:-

Item Give and bequeath unto my daughter Charlot and my three sons John Bath and
Thomas Lightfoot all the remainder of my Estate one negro stock of horses, cattle
Hogs and household furniture to be equally divided to them and their heirs
and assigns forever. I do hereby constitute my wife Eleanor Lightfoot Exec^{tr}
of this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have

At Greenville County Court February 1795. This Will was proved
 according to Law by the oaths of Edward Smith and Joseph Vincent Witnesses
 thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the Executrix therein named
 who made oath thereto and together with Joseph Vincent her Security returned
 into and acknowledged bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred Dollars condi-
 tioned as the Law directs. Certificate was granted her for obtaining a Probate
 thereof in due form.
