therein named who made shewels and together with James Teller and William W.
Wilkins his Executors entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of
One thousand thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted
to him for obtaining a probat of the said Will in due form

I John Percell of Greensville County and state of Virginia being weak in body and
sound mind and memory do make this my last will and testament in manner and form
as follows Viz First it is my will and desire that all my just debts should be paid.
Secondly I give all the rest of my Estate of what kind so ever both real and personal
to my beloved wife Elizabeth Percell to her and her heirs and assigns forever and
lastly I do hereby appoint and constitute my beloved wife Elizabeth Percell Execu-
trix and my friend James C. Percell executor to this my last will and testament
making all others by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand,

and seal this 12th July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen

Tammes my severely injured wife and acknowledged their debt in the penalty of One thousand Dollars Conditional as the Law directs Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.
