in manner and form as followeth, Vizt, In presence, I give to my
daughter Elizabeth Spence one negroe known by the Name of Jack
to her and her heirs forever, Item, I give to my daughter
Charlotte Spence one Negroe known by the name of Isabella
to her and her heirs forever. Item, I give to my daughter
Duliah Spence one Negroe known by the name of Lender to
her and her heirs forever, Item, I give to my daughter ^{Sarah} Spence
one Negroe known by the name of Hager to her and her heirs forever.
Item, I give to my daughter Priscilla Spence three Negroes
known by the Names of Edith, Zenah and Abel to her and
her heirs forever, Item, I give to my daughter Polly Spence
one Negroe known by the name of Abraham together with ten
Pounds current money of Virginia to be raised out of my Estate
to her and her heirs forever, Item, I give to my son John Spence
two Negroes known by the names of Gabby and Cain to him
and his heirs forever, Item, I give to my son Bartholomew

Spence three Negroes known by the Names of Hercules, Cherry,
and Jim to him and his heirs forever, Item, my Will and desire
is that my Negroes and Stock of all kinds be continued on the
Plantation ~~the year out to make a crop~~ and for my son
John Spence to have one fifth part of the crop that is made
on the Plantation, and the rest of the crop to be equally divided
amongst my eight Children to them and their heirs forever
I desire, ^{that} my Land and Plantation ^{be sold} by my Executors hereafter
mentioned and give Credit to the purchaser untill my son
John comes to the Age of twenty one Years old and the money
arising from such sale to be equally divided between my son
John Spence and Bartholomew Spence to them and their
heirs forever, Item, all the rest and residue of my Estate to be
sold by my Executor hereafter mentioned and equally divided
among all my eight children before mentioned to them and their
heirs forever, I nominate and appoint Jacob's Decy Executor of
this my last Will and testament revoking all other Wills
before by me made

John Spence an avaricious man Spence to them and their
heirs forever, I term, all the rest and residue of my Estate to be
sold by my Executor hereafter mentioned and equally divided
among all my eight children before mentioned to them and their
heirs forever, I nominate and appoint Jacob's my Executor of
this my last Will and Testament revoking all other Wills
before by me made, As I have hereunto set my Hand and seal
this 15th Day of March 1791.
