and her heirs forever If Pharahy should die under the age of
Eighteen Years to my desire is that the said Negroe should

Of sold and equally divided among my five Sons namely Lucas
Tomlinson, John Tomlinson, David Tomlinson, James Tomlinson and
Nathan Tomlinson. Item I give and bequeath to my Son William
Tomlinson one Negroe Girl named Lucy to him and his heirs for ever.
If William should die before he comes to the age of twenty one years old
my desire is that the above mentioned Negroe should be sold and equally
divided between my five above mentioned Sons Lucas, John, David,
James and Nathan. Item I lend unto my beloved Wife, Susanna
Tomlinson four Negroes. Phillis, Patt, Ambrose and Richmond and
all the rest of my personable Estate during her Life or Widowhood. And
then my desire is that the four Negroes and their increase that I lend to
my Wife should be equally divided between my five Sons and Daughter
Milored. Lucas Tomlinson, John Tomlinson, David Tomlinson,
James Tomlinson and Nathan Tomlinson and Milored Tomlinson
to them and their heirs and assigns for ever. My desire is that ~~all~~
my personable Estate that I lent my Wife should be equally divided
between my Son Nathaniel Tomlinson and my three Daughters
Elizabeth Cook, Mary Collier and Sarah Anderson to them and their
heirs for ever. My desire is that my Son James Tomlinson should be
maintained and to the house that I have my Wife during her Life.

of Lucas Tomlinson one of the Executors therein named who made
Oath thereto according to Law and together with John Pritchett

and Absalom Harris his Securities interceded and acknowledged
their Bond in the Penalty of One thousand five hundred Pounds
Specie conditioned as the Law directs Certificate was granted
him for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form. The other Executor
therein named refused to join in the burden of the execution thereof
