one feather Bed and furniture also five head of Cattle to her and her
heirs forever I am I give and bequeath to my ^{Daughter} Rebecca Whites one
feather Bed and furniture also the Cattle she now has in possession
I am I give all the Rest of my Estate, to my beloved wife Rebecca
Harris and I do hereby appoint my Sons William and Robert Harris
full and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament desiring
