to make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth:
viz: First and Principally I becom and my last to the charge of our mighty God
that gave it, hoping a gracious reception of the same and also what worldly goods it
hath pleased God to endow me with, I distribute in the following manner viz: First
I premise and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Dupree my whole Estate, Personal and
Real, untill my son Henry Dupree arrived to the age of twenty one Years or reaching
to each of my Children a Negro in manner as followeth, I give to my Daughter
Polly Dupree a Negro girl named Fenny. I give to my Daughter Elizabeth
Dupree, a Negro Boy named Matt. I give to my Daughter Hannah H.
Dupree, a Negro Boy named Ben. I give to my Daughter Faith H.
Dupree, a Negro Boy named London. I give to son Henry Dupree, a
Negro Boy called Buck, and if either of the above mentioned Negroes should die
that my Estate shall make it good to the Legacies. And that if either of my above
mentioned Children should die without their lawfully begotten, My Will and desire
is for the Negroes given them to return to my Estate again, and that with the residue of my
Estate to remain in the possession of my wife during her natural Life, and after her
Death to be equally divided amongst my Children, excepting my Land which
my Will and desire is that my son Henry Dupree shall have the whole of the same
My Will and desire is that it may be House and home for my Children untill they
shall marry or come of Lawful Age. My Will and desire is that if the Admin^{rs} of
this my last Will and Testament should see my Estate wasting in the life time of
my wife that they shall have it in their power to sell or direct any part of it as they
may judge to be best for the benefit of my Children.

that my Estate shall make it good to the Legates. And that if either of my above

is for the Negro given them to return to my Estate again, and that with the residue of my
Estate to remain in the possession of my Wife during her natural Life, and after her
Death to be equally divided amongst my Children, excepting my Land which
my Will and devise is that my son Henry Dupree shall have the whole of the same
My Will and desire is that it may be House and home for my Children untill they
shall marry or come of Lawful Age. My Will and desire is that if the Admin^{rs} of
this my last Will and Testament should see my Estate wasseing in the life time of
my Wife that they shall have it in their power to sell or direct any part of it as they
may judge to the benefit of my Wife and Children. It is my Will and desire that
the Administrators to this my Will shall have a full right in case they and my Wife
shall see an advantage to be made in my Estate to my Wife and Children that they
should

I do appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Dupree, my second Simon Turner of this County, and my Brother in Law Michael Warren whole and sole Executors to this my Last Will and Testament made by me. A Court held for Greensville County the 20th day of February 1708 This was Divided according to Law by the Oath of John Brett and John Dupree Witnesses before and Ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of Elizabeth Dupree and Michael Warren two of the Executors therein named who made Oath thereunto and together with John Morris and his son Morris their Securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in two thousand Pounds conditional as the Law directs and Liberate were granted them for obtaining a Probate thereof and the other Executors refused to join in the said Probate.
