In the name of God Amen I Littleton Sims of the County of
Greensville do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in
manner and form following to wit I leave all my Estate of
what kind soever to be equally divided between my Brother David
Sims and Wythe Sims if he should live to the age of Twenty one
years or married, but if my Brother Wythe Sims should die before
he comes of age or married my desire is that my Brother David Sims
shall have all my Estate to him and his heirs forever, I leave my
Brother David Sims Executor to this my last will and Testament with
my all others by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this 11th Day of June 1791 Littleton Sims [L.S.]
