In the name of God Amen I Margaret Solomon of Greenville  
County and Parish of Lebanon being in perfect Health of Body and  
mind and Memory thanks be to God for the same and calling to mind  
that it is appointed for all persons once to die do make and ordain this  
my last will and Testament that is to say first of all I give my  
soul to Almighty God that gave it me, and my body to it Mother Earth  
to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors  
after named mentioned nothing doubting but at the general resurrection  
to

to receive the same by the mighty Power of Almighty God and as touching  
such worldly goods as it has been pleased God to bless me with I demise and  
bequeath as follows (to wit) I give to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth  
Maffey one Negro Girl by the name of Fanny my wearing clothes and saddle  
to her and her heirs forever. Item I give to my Son John Arent one Negro Boy  
by the name of Glaston to him and his heirs forever. Item I give to the Children  
of Thomas Arent deceased the Children of James Arent the two Daughters of  
Molloy Tiller and the Daughter of Benj<sup>r</sup> Arent and the Son of John Tiller three  
Negroes namely Mary, Kate, and Bessie to be sold and the money to be divided  
between each and every one of them to purchase their heirs forever. Then I give  
and bequeath to Elizabeth Maffey, John Arent, my Daughter Son and my  
Grand Children before mentioned two Negro Girls by the name of Charlotte  
and Isabel with the balance of my Estate not before given away to be sold and  
equally divided as followeth to wit one share that is to say one part  
Elizabeth Maffey one to John Arent and to the Children of Thomas Arent  
and one to the two Daughters of Molloy Tiller and one to the Children of James Arent  
and one to the Daughter of Benjamin Arent and their heirs forever. Lastly I hereby appoint my  
entire and I do hereby certify that I have

Avant died to them and their heirs forever - I do hereby certify that I have read the foregoing will and Testament and I do hereby certify that I have read and disapproved all other wills and Legacies and bequests before made, on or in anywise ratifying and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament in which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th Day of February, 1804
