In the Name of God Amen. I Martha Williamson of the County of
 Greenville being sick of body but of sound mind and memory do make
 and ordain this my last Will and Testament revoking all others.
 First it is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid out of my
 Estate by my Executors. 2nd I give and bequeath to my grand daughter
 in Law Mary P. Adams all my Estate (to wit) my Stock of Horses,
 Cattle, Sheep, Hogs, and Fowl, I give her the said Mary P. Adams my
 Clothes my Cotton Cloth my Crops of all kinds, also my Plantation -
 utensils of every kind whatsoever with any other thing whatsoever
 that I am possessed of to her, her heirs or assigns forever. 3rd and lastly
 I appoint Henry Wyche jun^r Executor of this my last Will and Testament
 revoking all others. In witness whereof I the said Martha Williamson
 have hereunto set my Hand and seal the Day of One Thousand
 Eight Hundred and Two.
