At a Court held for Greensville County the 13th day of May 1816 This will was proved by the Oaths of Wm^{son} Bonner and George Cain the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded. and Thomas Spencer the executor named in the said will having appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the Execution thereof. On the motion of Addison Powell who made oath and together with William Mason and Thomas Spencer his Securities entered into and acknowledged their bond, in the penalty of Ten thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted. the said Powell for obtaining Letters of Administration on the said deceaseds Estate with the will aforesaid annexed in due form.
