Inprimis I give and bequeath to my son Kinchen Webb the following Negroes to wit Randolph Phil Hannah and Leah together with their increase also all the rest of my estate of what nature or kind soever not already disposed of to him his heirs and assigns forever. My desire is that the said Kinchen Webb let Nancy Vincent and her Children have twenty pounds out of my Estate for their support (as him the said Kinchen may think proper) but by no means to be at the disposal of her husband Michael Vincent. Also the forty pounds I left in a former will for my son Warren Webb to pay my Daughter Eliza Webb now Walker my will and desire is that he the said Warren should not pay the same, but be entitled to all the property he hath now in his possession which hath been Recorded to him in Greensville County Court prior to this Will to him his heirs and assigns forever. and lastly I constitute and appoint my Son Kinchen Webb and Benjamin Gowing Executors of this my last will and Testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made.
