

In the Name of God, Amen, I Moses Johnson of the
County of Greenville and Parish of Maherrin do make and ordain this to
be my last Will and Testament, Inprimus, I lend unto my wife Sarah
Johnson the plantation at this time cultivated by me with as much
woodland as may be sufficient for her support the said Land to be ad-
joining the cleared land, also the following property viz of my negroes
Peter, Pegg, Lucy, Isaac and Bett, two feather Beds, and furniture
one horse named Derrick, one woman's saddle and bridle, one fourth
part of my stock of hogs, cattle, sheep, and geese, one fourth part of my
Pewter and Table furniture during her natural life or widowhood
reserving to my son David Johnson the liberty of residing in the house he
now lives in with the privileges he at this time enjoys, Item, I give and
bequeath to my son David Johnson the tract of Land whereon I live
bounded as followeth, - Beginning at the state line where it crosses the
little creek, thence along the said line to Nathan Johnson's line, thence
along his line to William Vaughan's line, thence along his line to Benjamin
Edwards's line, thence along his line to Henry Chambliss's line, thence

bequeath to my son David Johnson the tract of Land whereon I live
bounded as followeth, - Beginning at the state line where it crosses the
little creek, thence along the said line to Nathan Johnson's line, thence
along his line to William Vaughans, thence along his line to Benjamin
Edwards's line, thence along his line to Henry Chambliss's - Thence
along his line to the little creek, thence up the said creek to the Beginning,
three negroes, viz^t Minna, Isabel, and Lewis, and their increase together
with all the property that I have heretofore put in his possession to him
and his heirs forever. Item, I give and bequeath to my son Moses Johnson
one set of black-smith's tools, three negroes, viz, Edy, Bunch, and Chaney,
with their increase together with all the property that I have heretofore
put in his possession to him and his heirs forever. - Item, I give and
bequeath to my son Nathan Johnson the following Negroes, Harry, Will,
Moll, Fanny, Fred, Tib, and Seliza, and their increase one feather Bed
and furniture one half my pewter, table and kitchen furniture, one
flax-wheel and Hackel, twelve head of cattle, six head of sheep, and
twenty five pounds cash to him and his heirs forever together with all the
property

property heretofore in his possession. Item, My will and desire is that my
Hill and Handmill remain on the Plantation whereon I live for the use of
my wife and my sons David, Moses, and Nathan. Item, provides my
Grandson Elijah Moore arrives to the age of twenty one years or has lawful
Issue of his body I give him two negroes, viz. Sue, and Dick with her increase.
But if he should die under age, or leave no lawful issue then it is my will
that the Legacy given him be divided between my sons David, Moses,
and Nathan to them, and their heirs forever. Item, My will and
desire is that the remainder of my Estate including my outstanding
Debts, together with the personal property lent my wife (after her death or
widowhood), be equally divided between my sons David, Moses, and Nathan,
(my debts being first paid) to them and their heirs forever. Item,
My will and desire is that my Estate be not appraised. Lastly, I
nominate and appoint my wife, my sons, David, Moses, and Nathan,
Executors to this my last will and Testament making void all others here-
tofore by me made as Wt. Witness my hand and seal this twelfth day of
April 1789.

This Will was proved according to Law by
the Oaths of Thomas Richardson and William
Folkes witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded
And on the motion of David Johnson, Moses

Johnson and Nathan Johnson the Executors therein named who made
Oath thereto, and together with Achilles Jeffries and James Hinton
their securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty
of five thousand pounds conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is
granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form,
