My desire is that John Agent, Jos. Henry, Wyche, and Samuel Agent make a equal Division of all my Estate between my two Sons, to wit William & Jephtha Popper. And lastly I do hereby appoint my Son William Popper Executor of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all others. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and Seal this 4 day of May 1813.
