third day of July in the Year of our Lord one Thousand eight
Hundred and Two, make and publish this my last Will and
Testament in manner following. Inprimis, It is my will
and desire that my Executors hereafter named shall sell any of
my Negroes, and whatever part of my Stock, Crop and Household
or Kitchen furniture he may deem necessary for the payment
of my just Debts. I then I send unto my loving Mother
Priscilla Williamson my Plantation in Northampton County
(on the road leading from Cator's Ferry to Hicks's Ford)
also the nine following Slaves, Nanny, Tom, Joe, Charles,
Ephraim, Nelson, Wm. & J. & Peter & L.

or Kitchen Furniture he may deem necessary for the payment
of my just Debts. Item I lend unto my loving Mother
Priscilla Williamson my Plantation in Northampton County
(on the road leading from Cato's Ferry to Hicks's Ford)
also the nine following Slaves, Nanny, Tom, Joe, Charles,
Ephraim, Nelson, Milly and her two Children, Harriott and
Nancy, all my Stock, Crop, Household and Kitchen Furniture,
Plantation Utensils and Carriage, during her natural life, for
the use of herself and my Children. — Item I give to my
Daughter Sarah Edwards, one negroe girl Harriott (Daughter
of Milly) to her and her heirs. — Item I give to my Daughter
Rebecca Edwards one negroe girl Nancy (Daughter of Milly) to her
and her heirs. — Item it is my Will and Desire that all my
Estate both real and personal (at the death of my Mother) not
already

471) already disposed of, be equally divided between my five Children. Isaac Edwards, Nelson Edwards, Sarah Edwards, William Edwards, and Rebecca Edwards, share and share alike. — Item, It is my will and desire that my Executor hereafter named should give no security, and should not be compelled to have my personal Estate appraised. — Item I hereby make and ordain my loving Brother Ben Williamson Executor of this my last Will and Testament. — In Witness whereof I the said Priscilla Edwards to this my last Will and Testament have set my Hand and Seal the day and Year above Written.
