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I Robert W Land of the County of Greensville and State of Virginia do hereby
make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say:
It is my wish and desire that all my Just Debts and funeral Expenses be first paid
out of my Estate; after which it is my will and desire that my Estate both real and
personal Land and Negroes be equally divided between my loving wife Sally and
my Son Thomas Speed Land; during my wifes widowhood it is also my wish
if my wife should marry again that one third of her part of my Estate should be
added to my Son Thomas's part - and for the true performance of this my last
Will and Testament I appoint my friends John Stewart and Conrad Stewart in
whole and sole Executors, no Security required. In Testimony whereof, I have hereunto
set and affixed my hand and Seal, this Tenth day of August one thousand eight
hundred and Ten.
