with I dispose of it in the manner and form following. First It is my
Will and desire that my Executors hereafter mentioned sell to the best
advantage all my Stock of Cattle Sheep and Hogs Four head of Horses
and one Mule Two Leather Beds one negro Man by the name of
George and all my Household & Kitchen furniture except six Beds &
furniture and the money arising from the sale to be applied to the payment
of my just debts the surplus or remainder to be equally divided betwixt
my three Daughters Polly Wall Lucy Wall & Sarah Elizabeth Wall to
them and their heirs forever. Secondly I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Jane Gray & her the following Slaves to wit Kate, Sally
and Aaron and their increase also one feather Bed and furniture
her and her heirs forever. Thirdly I give and bequeath to my daughter
Sally Wall the following Slaves, to wit, Isham, Leah, and little Sarah
and their increase to her and her heirs forever.

Firstly I will the following Slaves, to wit, Isham, Leah, and Little Sarah
and their increase and one feather Bed and furniture to her and her heirs
forever. Secondly I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Madul
the following Slaves to wit Hagar and Moses and their increase to her and
her heirs forever. Thirdly I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Wall
the following Slaves to wit Great Sarah Ann her Child Francis
and their increase and one feather Bed to her and her heirs forever.

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Elizabeth Wall the
following Slaves to wit Betty Austin and Bobb, their increase and one
feather Bed to her and her heirs forever. Seventhly I give and bequeath to
my Grand son ~~to~~ Joseph Gray Wall one negro Girl by the name of Beck
Daughter of Great Sarah to him and his heirs forever. Eighthly My will
and desire is that the remainder of my Estate not before mentioned may be
divided betwixt my Children agreeable to the last Will and Testament of
my late Husband James Wall deceased. Lastly I do hereby appoint
my friends Henry Tazewell, John Goodwyn, and Gershom Watson Executors

Witnesses not appearing further to prove the same on the Motion of the
