Davis all my Estate of Negroes and other personal Estate during their
natural life and after their Decease I give unto Laurenchia House's
Daughter a Martha House as much of my said Estate as will buy
her a Saddle and a good Suit of clothes and all the rest of Estate that
remains after the Death of my aforesaid Uncle and Aunt to be equally
divided amongst all my half Brothers and Sisters to them and their
heirs and assigns forever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and Seal this the eighth day of February One thousand
hundred and eighty five.

having made Oath thereto and together with Thomas Camp Morris
his Security entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the County

of One thousand pounds conditioned as the Law directs.
Certificate was granted him for obtaining Letters of Administration
of the said Testator's Estate with the said Will annexed and due from

In the Name of God Amen I Sabtha Lucas
of the County of Greenville am very sick and weak but of sound sense
and disposing Mind do make this my last Will and Testament in
manner and form following. I Give and bequeath to my Son
Nathaniel Lucas two Cows and twelve Pigs One half of my Pewter
One Hoghead of Cotton One Large Chest to him and his heirs for ever.
I Give and bequeath to my Son Edmund Lucas One Negroe Woman
Agga her and her future increase the Mill and all my Stock of
Cattle One feather Bed and furniture the Cart Wheels Ten Hogs his
choice the remainder of my Pewter which I have not given away with
all my Kitchen furniture the Horse called Dolphin and the Grey Cows
also a sufficiency of Corn to serve him and his family till the new
crop comes in One Gallon One Pint, and One Gill of all my liquors
and Plantation Tools five Pigs and all my Cyder baskets all my
Chairs Tables Run kippers &c &c &c
