In the name of God & Amen, I, Silas C. Collier, of the County of Greensville
State of Virginia being very sick and weak, but in perfect mind and memory
thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body and know-
ing that it is appointed for all men once to die, I do make and ordain this my
Last Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give
and recommend my soul, into the hands of the almighty God that giveth and

46 my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian
burial, at the discretion of my Executors in Newburg but at the
general resurrection I shall receive the same again, by the mighty
power of God, and as touching such worldly Estates wherewith it
hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give, devise, and dispose of
the same in the following manner and form.

First I give and bequeath to my Son Moses Collier one Sow and five
pigs I also give unto my Daughter Mary Collier one pecked horse and
I also wish for my Debts to be paid out of the balance of my Estate
and the balance to be sold and equally divided between all my Children
namely, William Morgan, Jesse Archer, William Collier, Mary
Collier, Vincent Collier, Lucy Johnson, Moses Collier, John Collier to
them and their heirs forever. my Son William Collier, and my Cousin
Young Johnson, I constitute make and ordain my Executors to this
my last Will and Testament. I do hereby utterly disallow revoke
and disannull all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies
bequests and Executors by me in any ways before Willed and bequeathed
ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testa-
ment In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and added

Young I Johnson, I constitute make and ordain my Executor to this
my last Will and Testament. I hereby utterly disallow revoke
and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies
bequests and Executors by me in any ways before Willed and bequeathed
ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Test

this 17th Day of December, in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and
Seven.
