

I M the name of God Amen I Thomas Fox of the County of Greensville State of Virginia being weak in mind and body but thanks be to God of sound mind and memory in coming to mind the mortality of my body and that I am appointed for all rain come to die do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows to wit, first I give my wife and wife is for my just debts to be paid. Item the 2nd I give unto my loving wife Sarah in during her life two Negroes named Nathaniel & Ramond, and at her death my will and desire is that the said two Negroes Nathaniel and Ramond be sold and the money arising from such sale equally divided between my Daughters namely, Mary Louisa Fox otherwise Smith, and Rebecca Ireland Fox to them their heirs and assigns forever. Item the 3rd my will and desire is, namely my son James Fox comes into the County of Greensville himself I give and bequeath unto said Negro named Beck to him his heirs and assigns forever but in case my son James Fox should not come himself for said Negro Beck then and in that case the said Negro Beck is to stay with my said wife during her natural life and at her death the said Negro Beck is to be sold and is to remain all my Children except my son Thomas Fox. Item the 4th I give and bequeath unto my son William Fox otherwise Smith one Negro Girl named Lereas to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item the 5th I give and bequeath unto my son Gideon Fox otherwise Smith one Negro named Beck to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item the 6th I give and bequeath unto my son John L. Fox one Negro boy named Isaac to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item the 7th I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Louisa Fox otherwise Smith one Negro named Sam to her, her heirs and assigns forever. Item the 8th I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca Ireland Fox

that we said two negroes named Rachel and Diamond be sold and the money arising from said sale
 equally divided between my Daughters named Mary Louisa Fox otherwise Smith and Rebecca
 Fox to them their heirs and assigns forever. Item the 3rd my will and desire is, that
 my son James Fox comes into the County of Greensville himself I give and bequeath unto him
 a Negro named Beck to him his heirs and assigns forever but in case my son James Fox should
 come himself for said Negro Beck then and in that case the said Negro Beck is to stay with
 said wife during her natural life and at her death the said Negro Beck is to be sold and
 among all my Children except my son Thomas Fox. Item the 4th I give and bequeath unto my
 William Fox otherwise Smith one Negro Girl named Dorcas to him his heirs and assigns forever
 Item the 5th I give and bequeath unto my son Federal Fox otherwise Smith one Negro named Beck
 to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item the 6th I give and bequeath unto my son Federal Fox
 one Negro boy named Isaac to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item the 7th I give and bequeath
 unto my Daughter Mary Louisa Fox otherwise Smith one Negro named Liza to her, her heirs
 and assigns forever. Item the 8th I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca otherwise Fox
 two Negroes named Aggett and Mason to her her heirs and assigns forever. Item the 9th I give and
 bequeath unto my son Thomas Fox three Negroes named Lang, Curdall and Catty they being the
 same the three Negroes he has now in his possession to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item
 the 10th my will and desire is that my children as before named shall all have their property as
 they arrive of age or as they may, but to stay on my Plantation untill then, with, with my said
 Wife for the following purposes viz^t the support of them my before named children that is now

395/ with me, Item the 11th my will and desire is that all my stock of all kinds also all my household and
kitchen furniture and ~~plate~~ ^{GreenSVille County Virginia Wills Book 2 1806 to 1816} ~~all my furniture~~ to keep on my plantation for the use of my said
wife during her natural life except one feather bed and furniture which I give to my daughter Mary
Louisa Fox otherwise I Smith to her her heirs and assigns forever. Item the 12th my will and desire is that
my wife keep all my Land until my son Gideon Fox otherwise Smith comes of age or marries and either
case, I then give him the before named Gideon my Land from the gulch below the road per Providence
to the great swamp and thence from the other end of the gulch to Isham Howell line it being the
whole of my land, from thence towards Upshaw Jones to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item the
13th my will and desire is that my son Gideon as before named shall have all my Land on the north
side of the mining swamp it being the Land I purchased of Jabez Morris at the death of my wife
Saurina Fox to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item the 14th my will and desire is at the death
of my said wife that my son John & Fox shall have all my Land on the south side of the mining
Swamp it being all the Land I purchased of Isaac Howell to him his heirs and assigns forever
Lastly I nominate and appoint my trusty friend William Robinson and my wife my sole Execu-
tors to this my last will and testament working all other wills by me heretofore made, Signed
sealed and acknowledged this sixteenth day of February one thousand eight hundred and fifteen

At a court held for Greensville County the 12th day of June 1815 This will
was proved by the oaths of Henry Davis and Isaac Rowell two of
the Justices thereof and ordered to be recorded. ~~And the same~~
William Robinson and Lavinia Fox the Ex. They have named who made oath and together
with Augustine Claiborne and Edmunds whom their said Ex. called into and acknowledged
that bond in the penalty of ten thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is given
them for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.
