Item I give to my sons Isaac & Edmund Branscomb the land of Land whereon they both live containing one hundred and fifty two acres to be equally divided to them and their heirs forever. Item I give to my beloved wife Tabitha Branscomb all my personal Estate to her use during her life and after her death it is my will & desire that it shall go to my son Robert Branscomb to him and his heirs forever.
