400. Household and Kitchen furniture and all the rest of my Estate except
my clothes which I give to my Two Brothers John and William
Randle and I appoint Bracon Robinson my only Executor in which
whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th Day of
September One Thousand Seven Hundred and ninety four. It is my
