

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Jordan of
Greensville County being weak in Body but in sound Memory thank be to
almighty God do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament hereby
Revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made; IMprimis First of all I
desire that my Body maybe decently buried at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter mentioned and next that my just Debts be paid and as to the rest
of my Estate I give and dispose of in manner following to wit, I give to
my Son Jesse Jordan One hundred and fifty Acres whereon he now lives
also part of my Land in Carolina adjoining the said Jesse Jordan supposed
to contain twenty five Acres bounded by the great Branch James Blatts
line Deceased and his own line also three Negroes to wit, Lem and Perry
which he hath now in his possession. One Negro Girl by name Edith,
and the first Child my Negro Woman Dinah shall have. Item I give
to my Son Henry Jordan my Land and Plantation whereon I now live
containing One hundred and fifty Acres more or less also One hundred
and fifteen Acres adjoining in North Carolina to him his heirs and assigns
for ever Also I give to my Son Perry Jordan two Negroes by name
Sydia and Amey Also the first Child my Negro Woman Sarah shall
have to him his heirs and assigns for ever. Item I lend to my Daughter
Temperance B. L. V.

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have to him his heirs and assigns for ever. I then I send to my Daughter
Temperance Bass three Negroes to wit, My Negro Boy in her possession
called Nathan also my Negro Boy Isaac, and my Negro Girl called Milly
But nevertheless if my Daughter Temperance Bass shall live to have
a Heir of her Body, I give the before mentioned Negroes to her and her heirs for
ever. I then I send to my Grand Daughter Betsey Ellis two Negroes to wit,
my Negro boy Moses and Negro Girl Charlotte, but in case my Grand
Daughter Betsey Ellis shall live to have a child lawfully begotten of her
Body, I give the said Negroes to her and her heirs for ever. I Will that if either
my Daughter or Grand Daughter shall die without Issue as above mentioned
Child that the part so lent or given be equally divided between my two Sons
Jesse and Henry Jordan or their heirs the rest of my Estate not before given
I Will to be equally divided between my Son Jesse, Henry and Daughter
Temperance. I do nominate and appoint my two Sons Jesse and Henry
Jordan Executors of this my last will. In Witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand and affixed my Seal this fifteenth day of September 1797

In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Wager,
do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say. First
I give and bequeath to Rebecca Clark five Negroes to wit, Robt. Violet, Manlow
Nancy and Billy provided she pays to Mary Massing eldest Daughter
of Henry Smith and Elizabeth Tuckins Daughter of George Bryer each
fifteen hundred pounds of Petersburg Inspected Crop Tobacco. and shall
either pay up the said Tobacco before the Negroes are delivered or give Bonds
and such Security as my Executors hereafter mentioned shall think
sufficient. Item I give and bequeath to Mary Smith Daughter of
Samuel Magot One Negroe Girl named Sally to her and her heirs for ever
Item I give and bequeath to Nicholas Bryer two Negroes, to wit, Mary and
her Male Child to him and his for ever. Item I give and bequeath to
William Tomlinson One hundred pounds Lawful Money of Virginia
to him and heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to Rebecca Waller
Daughter of William Waller Twenty pounds Lawful Money of Virginia
