

In the name of God Amen I, Timothy Allen of the County of Greensville
and State of Virginia being weak in Body but of sound mind and memory
do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form
following. I leave my will and desire is for all my Just Debts to be paid,
Then I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza Allen when she arrives to the
age of Eighteen years of age or marries one Negro Girl by name of Felpah
if obtained as I have a suit depending for the said Girl with George Thawell
also one feather Bed and furniture and one Seal. Then I leave in like manner
to her and her heirs forever. Then I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Allen the following Property to wit one Negro Girl named Ancona with
feather Bed and furniture and one lace blue Christ when she arrives
to the age of Eighteen years or marries to her her heirs and assigns forever
in Case one of my before named Children should die without an heir it
is my Will the other should have that property. Then I give and bequeath
unto my beloved Wife Lucy Allen all the residue of my household and
Kitchen Furniture also one Black Mare also I leave her all the residue of
my estate both real and personal so long as she remains my Widow my will
and desire is that in case both my Children should die before they arrive
to the age of Eighteen or marries in that case to return to my wife Lucy Allen

age of eighteen or more in that case to return to my wife but in case
my wife should die before that period I leave to my Brothers and Sister
and Nancy Allen my Niece in equal division. I am the executor and appoint
my wife's Law Agent and my Brother James Allen and Executors to that
my last Will and Testament. Now it is my will and desire should my
Wife die or succeed before my children arrives to the age of eighteen or more
for my Land not to be sold nor the Negroes hired, but to remain on the said
Land and work on the Land aforesaid executing all Wills heretofore made by
me. In Witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this 26th
twenty sixth Day of August 1804.

Administration on the said Testator's Estate with the will annexed in due form. She
