Item I give to my son Daniel Robinson Fifty acres of Land that I purchased of William Ferguson, upon his paying the rest of my Children one hundred Dollars. And my will and desire is that all the balance or residue of my Estate not before mentioned or disposed of shall be equally divided between all my Children at my death. — Item I do nominate and appoint my four Sons John, William, Daniel, and David Robinsons Executors to this my last will and Testament revoking all others.
