of Jesse Jordan one of the Executors therein named who made oath thereto
and with Joseph Turner his security entered into and acknowledged their
Bond in the penalty of Two Thousand Dollars with condition as the Law
directs. Certificate was granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in

In the Name of God Amen I William Turner of the State of
Virginia and County of Greensville being not in health, but in perfect memory
and senses do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in
manner and form as followeth vizt I give bequeath to my beloved
Brother J. Blunt Turner, and ^{Greensville Virginia Wills 1790 to 1800} ^{www.virginiapioneers.net} to my Brother the Land
being

lying between the Road and Meherrin River them and their heirs forever
 to be equally divided. Item I give to Brother Sigers Turner the Land lying
 on the South side of the Road joining John Morris's line and Blunt Turner's
 also half the Land John Wall now lives on to him and heirs forever,
 and the other part to James Turner and his heirs forever. Item Give
 and bequeath to my Brother J. Blunt Turner Negro by name of Ned to
 him and his heirs forever, And also the residue of my Negroes to be
 equally divided between J. Blunt Turner & Sigers Turner & Simon,
 Thomas & James and Nancy Turners to them and their heirs forever
 also my Bedding Ware to my Sister Nancy Turner. I leave in the
 hands of Sigers Turner One Hundred pounds for the support of my
 Sister Mary Wall and also for the said Sigers Turner to keep the said
 Money in his hands and bestow it as he thinks proper If the said Mary
 Wall should not live to enjoy it my desire is that the said Money should
 descend to her Son Albert Wall. And also the residue of my Estate to be
 equally divided between my Brothers J. Blunt Turner & Sigers Turner &
 Simon Turner & Thomas Turner & James Turner & Sister Nancy Turner
 except my part of the debt which I owe to my Mother in law

except my part of the beop which I give to my Mother, and for her
to let Mary Wall have ten Barrels of corn as she sees fit. In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and fixt my Seal this 8th
Day of May 1797.
