

In the name of God Amen I Young I Johnson of the County of Greenwell
 and state of Virginia being weak and low in health but thanks be to God of sound
 mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in
 manner and form following (Viz); first I give to my Sister Winifred Johnson the
 Land and plantation whereon I now live beginning at a pine ^{tree} at the mill path at
 Timothy Allens line thence down as the crop fence goes to the great branch thence
 down the said branch to the Beaver pond Creek thence down said Creek to McShells
 branch thence up said branch to Allens line thence along the said Allens line to the
 beginning also four Negroes namely Ben, Betty, her wife Isaac and John also four
 cows and calves also one horse a dark bay and one Dragoon filly with a sufficiency
 of plantation utensils to work her said lands, I wish to be left to two good men chosen
 for that purpose for which my said Sister Winifred Johnson is to have the right to
 name the two men herself. And also I give her two sows and pigs and also a suffi-
 ciency of stock for her one year and seventy five barrels of fall Corn; also two feather
 beds and double set of furniture her choice, also one large covered trunk also one blue
 painted chest one hief and as many of Butter and fall pots as she wants, six pewee
 and forks, and six pewee plates, also fodder sufficient for her stock, one year also
 six rolling chairs, also one pair of flat Irons, also one pine table but in case my sister
 Winifred Johnson should die without an heir lawfully begotten of her body then and in

two forks, and six plaster plates, also fodder sufficient for her stock, one year and
sixty colling chairs, also one pair of flat Irons, also one pine table but in case my sister
Minfred John - should die without an heir lawfully begotten of her body then and in
that case my will and desire is the aforesaid property is to return to my heirs in per
petuity equally. Secondly I give to my sister Abby Johnson's son Samuel Johnson the
following property to wit two Negroes namely Willen and Cherry which is to be put in
possession of my brother William Johnson till Samuel Johnson arrives to the age of twenty
one years for the purpose of their hire to school said Samuel Johnson which said two
Negroes I give to him and to his heirs lawfully begotten. Thirdly I give to Daniel
Johnson the following property to wit one Negro Girl named Mason to have her heirs
forever. fourthly I give to John Johnson the following property to wit one Negro boy named
Clairborne to have ^{his} heirs forever. fifthly I give to my brother James Johnson two hun
dred dollars to him his heirs forever. Sixthly I give to my Brother William John
son all the balance of my estate both real and personally of any nature or kind
whatsoever provided he pay my just debts to him forever my will will I desire is that my
Brother William Johnson and my sister Minfred Johnson take the property of John
and Daniel Johnsons and keep for them till they arrive to the age of twenty one years
Seventhly my will and desire is if either of the aforesaid Legatees should die with
out an heir lawfully begotten in that case the surviving ones in that case is to have them

following property to wit two Negroes namely Willen and Cherry which is to be put in
possession of my brother William Johnson till Samuel Johnson arrives to the age of twenty
one years for the purpose of their hire to school said Samuel Johnson which said two
Negroes I give to him and to his heirs lawfully begotten. Thirdly I give to Daniel
Johnson the following property to wit one Negro Girl named Mason to have her heirs
& forever. fourthly I give to John Johnson the following property to wit one Negro boy named
Clairborne to him ^{his} heirs & forever. fifthly I give to my brother James Johnson two hun-
dred Dollars to him his heirs & forever. sixthly I give to my Brother William John-
son all the balance of my estate both real and personally of every nature or kind
whatever provided he pay my just debts to him forever my will will I desire is that my
Brother William Johnson and my Sister Elizabeth Johnson take the property of John
and Daniel Johnsons and keep for them till they arrive to the age of twenty one years
Seventhly my will and desire is if either of the aforesaid Legatees should die with-
out an heir lawfully begotten in that case the Surviving ones in that case is to have their
proportionable part. Eighthly and lastly I nominate and appoint my Brother William
Johnson and my friend Benjamin Woodruff Sole Executors to this my last will and
Testament revoking all other Wills by me made signed sealed & acknowledged in
presence of us

365/ County the 8th day of August 1814. This will has proved by the Oaths of the Witnesses there
to and ordered to be Recorded. And on the motion of Benjamin Woodrooff one of the Execu-
tors therein named who made Oath Hurd and together with Aunt Mafsey, Nathaniel
Rebles and Samuel Aunt his Securities entered into and acknowledged their bond on
the penalty of Twenty thousand Dollars Conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is
granted the said Benjamin Woodrooff for obtaining & perfect of the said will in due
form.
