In the Name of God Amen. I Benjamin Sedman of Halifax County being weak in body but in perfect mind and Memory thanks be to God for it, do make this my last Will and Testament, and dispose of what it has pleased God to give me

in the following manner and form. I will that all my just Debts be first paid, and desire is that my Land may be sold by my Executors, and all my other Effects, and that after my Debts are paid that my wife Mary Sedman shall have one third part of the Money that remains, and I give to my son Ephraim Sedman the other two thirds, and to be kept in the hands of my Executors or by him put out on Interest till he arrives of age, if he dies before he is of an Age that it may be equally divided between my two Brothers Joseph and Sedman Support and constitute Cap. John Lawrie my executor and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and desire that he may have the Justice and

bringing up of my son at his discretion and that the Cost of his schooling come out of his Estate and that he be put to a Trade. Inwitness whereof I have set my hand and Seal this fifteenth day of January 1771.

The last Will and Testament of Benjamin Reardon deceased was proved by the Oath of three of the witnesses thereto subscribed and sworn to before me. And John Lawson the Executor herein named refusing to take upon him the Oath of Office and to pay the Debts and Liabilities of the Testator being in Court renounced and disclaimed all benefit under the same, whereupon a Commission of the Estate was granted to the said Testator with the said Will annexed was granted to James Beall & others according to Law, Isaac Rice became the Security and they entered into an Acknowledgement Bonds for the same.
