frying Pan two dishes Twelve Plates Six Barsen Six Coors and eight Shup
also One hundred Acres of Land. also one dog of the Choice of my dogs
Item I Give unto my son James after my Wife's Marriage or decease the above four
Negroes, one large Iron Pot called Consens and the Choice of one of my best Shirts
Item I Give unto my son James with all my wearing Cloaths
Item I Give all the rest or residue of my Estate of what Nature soever to be sold
and equally divided amongst my Children.

Lastly I Appoint and Nominate my son James Turner and my Wife & pper upon
James Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others
In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and Affix my
