In the Name of God Amen. I, Jonah Tully of Natifor County Truly
being very weak and in a low state of health but of a sound disposing mind and memory, thanks
be to almighty God for it, but calling to mind the certainty of death, and the uncertainty
of life, knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make Constitute and
appoint this to be my last Will and Testament, humbly giving my soul to almighty God that
gave it me, and my body to be buried as the discretion of my beloved wife and
for what worldly Estate wherewith it please God to bless me with in this life. I give and
bequeath in the manner and form following viz. first my desire is that my just debts should
be paid with my present standing debts and my bequest of Debts. I then bequeath to my beloved

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Wife my Lands and Plantation my Negro man Robin, Negro Woman Lucy, Negro boy
 No. Negro boy Peter, and after my Mother decess my Negro man Stephen, also all
 my household and plantation Cattelalls, and all my Stock of horn cattle, sheep and hogs
 and all my Estate that is not mentioned, real and personall, the use of them ^{the} to support
 and schooling my five children John Farley, Henry Farley, Sarah Farley, Mary Farley
 and Hannah Farley during her Widowhood or untill my son Henry comes to the age
 of Twenty one, and when my son Henry comes to the age of Twenty one then I give my
 Lands and Plantation to my two sons John Farley and Henry Farley to be equally divided between
 them, to them and their Heirs and Assigns forever, and my Negroes and Personall Estate
 with the issues to be equally divided between myself ~~between~~ and my beloved Wife
 if living and not living when my son Henry comes to the age of Twenty one, years
 I give it to be equally divided between them, to them and their Heirs and Assigns forever.
 I am also contented and appoint my beloved Wife and my friends Marmaduke
 Standfords and friends Timothy Bungee, whole and sole Executors of this
 my last Will and Testament, executing all other Wills whatsoever heretofore made by me
Witness about these minutes at my hand and seal the tenth day of June
 One thousand seven hundred and seventy four.

 That last Will and Testament of Josiah Farley deceased, was presented in Court by Marmaduke

 securities entered into and acknowledge this Bond with Condition according to Law
