I give and bequeath to my Daughter Cathine Juven one Bone Mare - by the name of Blaze - Item, my faith Will and desire is that after the death of my Wife my Es^{ts} shall as soon as may be convenient be put to publick sale and singular my Real and personal Estate without exception of the various kind in which it Consists as hasten done before saying such Articles as I have already given and bequeath and the Money arising from such sale to be Equally Divided Between my Daughters Cathine Juven, Margat Brandham and Anna Lawson to be to them and their heirs Lawfully begotten of their Boddiess for ever - and further & lastly. I do hereby Constitute Ordain and appoint Thomas Brandham Cathine Juven my whole and sole Es^{ts} of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 19th Day of May Anno 1785.
