In the name of God, Amen. I David Wall of
County of Halifax, being sick & weak of body, but of Perfect Sense
and Memory, thanks be to God for the same, do make & ordain this
my last will & Testament, (hereby revoking all other will or Wills
heretofore made) as followeth (To wit)

Item I give & bequeath to my son John Wall, one negro boy named
Harry, & one Negro Girl named Warner, to him his heirs and af-
fines forever, also one feather Bed & furniture, two Mares one called
Toby, the other a dark Gray with a Star in her forehead to him the
said John Wall his heirs & Affines forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Robert Wall one negro man
named Prince (being the eldest of that name) also one Negro girl
named Esther, also one Bay Gelding which he commonly rides and
one feather Bed & furniture to him, his heirs & Affines forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Byrd Wall one negro man named
Sam, and one Negro woman named Sarah to him his heirs & Affines
forever, also one feather bed & furniture.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Catherine Faulkner
one young negro Woman named Tamer & one Negro girl named
Luck to her her heirs forever also a smaller Negro girl named
Proprietor named Silvia, to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Patty Clay one Negro
Woman named Tamm, also one Negro Girl named Sarah to
her & her heirs forever.

also one feather bed & furniture, to him his heirs & Affines forever.
Item I give & bequeath to my son Charles Wall one negro man
(or lad) named Prince also one negro girl named Effy, to him his
heirs & Affines forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son David Wall (otherwise David
Soggan) one negro man named Adam, also a negro Child if it should
be born alive, of which my negro Woman named Amy is now pregnant
to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Parham Wall before mentioned,
one Negro woman named Amy in addition to what I have before
given him, to him his heirs & Affines forever.

Item It is my will & desire that the tract of Land wherein
I now live, be equally divided between my two sons Parham Wall
and Charles Wall, which said Land I give to them, their heirs and
Affines forever.

Item It is also my Will and desire that
my tract of Land on both sides of Coopers Creek, at the mouth of
the said, be equally divided between the rest of my sons (viz)
David, Byrd, John, & Robert Walls which said I give to them, their
heirs & Affines forever. Item It is also my Will & desire that the
land which I entered for a Cavalry against War. & Hosts which land
my fishing place is on the south side of San River, I give to my
son Byrd Wall & John Faulkner which land I give to them, their
heirs & Affines forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Parham
Wall one bay horse which he commonly rides in addition to what
I have already given him, to him his heirs & Affines forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my sons, John Robert, Parham & Charles
Walls twenty four head of Cattle to be equally divided between my
sons, John, Robert, Parham & Charles Walls in addition to what
I have already given them, to them their heirs & Affines forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son John Wall one grey mare
which he commonly rides in addition to what I have already given
