In the name of God Amen Catherine White of the County of Halifax being in perfect health since and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of this transitory life knowing it is appointed once for all to die do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament as touching such worldly Estate I have placed at my right hand to give me I give and devise in the following manner I give I bequeath unto my daughter Ann Tunstall and son in law Dr^r Ann Tunstall three negroes named Cuffa Rochester and my negro woman Rachel and her future increase during their natural lives I give and bequeath to John Chandler my negro man George on Condition that he pay to my daughter Ann Tunstall fifty five pounds and that he make her a good and lawful right to my negro man Cuffa that I exchange with him but in case the said Dr^r Chandler refuses to comply as above then the exchange to be totally void and that I bequeath the said negro man George with my others as aforesaid. I give to my Grand daughter Eliza Tunstall my negro boy Rochester after the death of my daughter Ann Tunstall and her husband John Ann Tunstall to her and her heirs forever lawfully begotten and in case she should die without issue I give said negro boy to my Grand daughter Franky Haly to her and her heirs forever. I give and bequeath to my Grand

daughter Nancy Hutchinson wife of Thomas Hutchinson. then pounds pence in
such measures as my Executors shall think necessary for and during the term
of ten years then given and bequeath all the rest and residue of my Estate to be
equally divided between my Grand daughter Franky Haley and Elizabeth
Tunstall after the death of my daughter Ann Tunstall and my son in law
John Aris Tunstall to them and their heirs forever and lastly I appoint
Joseph Egberton Hayle and John Aris Tunstall Executors of this my last
Will and Testament revoking and disannulling all other Will or Wills heretofore by
me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal
