In the Lord one thousand Eight hundred & two March the fourth day, I being in a low State of health but sound in mind & memory not knowing how soon it may please the Lord to call me from this State of life and feel myself desirous to dispose of my worldly goods as followeth I give & bequeath to Dear beloved wife Elizabeth Combs all my household furniture also three Cows & Calves one small man on a Sorellcott during her life or widowhood my desire is that my land and the rest of my Stock be converted to the use of paying my debts, and if there should be more money arising from said sale I refer it to my aforesaid Wife Elizabeth Combs & after her decease or marrying, my desire is that my daughter Lucy C. Combs shall have ten pounds and an equal division with the rest of my children and an equal division to take place with the rest of my children. To wit, Molly, Sally, Elizabeth, Ann, Nancy, Alexander, William, Charles & Lucy C. Combs, and I give to Nancy Marklee a Cow. This being my last will and Testament.
