uncertainty of this mortal life doth dispose of all my worldly goods in the manner and form following (viz)
My desire is that my beloved wife Elizabeth Wall should have Perille possession of the Land & plantation
whereon I now live and and all the rest of my Personal Estate during her life and at her death to be divided
among my children in the manner following (viz) the upper part of my Land with the dwelling house I give to
my Son Edmund Wall and the lower part to John Wall a equalite to the line already marked and the
Land on Punchs Creek I give to Braxton Wall but if either of them should die without issue his
part to be divide between the other two. All my desire is that each of my children now single be
married equal in a bed and furnished a horse saddle cow and calf. I also give to my daughter Susan
Attison one negr. named Amy Also I give to Polly Trump one negr. named Rachel and I
desire that after my Wife's death a negr. named Ned may be sold and the money divided between

the children of my daughter Hannah Dodson I also give to my daughter Sarah Wall one negro nam'd Milly
and to my daughter Lucy Wall one negro nam'd Luce I also give to my son Braxton Wall one negro
girl nam'd Anne and to Sonson Wall one neg^r nam'd Lindsey also to my son Edmund Wall one negro
nam'd Peter all the Nam'ds of my Estate if any after the death of my wife to be equally divided among
all my children. And I do hereby Constitute and appt. this my last Will and Testament. Revoking all
other appointing my Eliz^b. Wall, W^m Stamps, Josiah Athens and Braxton Wall my Executors. —

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The within written Last Will and Testament of Charles Wall deceased was exhibited in Court
and proved by the oath of one of the Witnesses thereto Subscribed and sworn to be record. And on the
motion of Elizabeth Wall the Executrix & William Stamps, Josiah Athens & Braxton Wall
the Executors therein named who made oath according to law. Certificate is granted them for obtaining
probate thereof in due form, they giving Security; whereupon they together with Beverly
Parkdale & Daniel Brown their Securies, entered into & acknowledged their bond in the
penalty of twenty thousand dollars. Conditioned as the law directs. —
